At the end of 2019, the FFI Board of Directors and CEO were joyously reflecting on a very successful year of Journeys yielding a healthy financial surplus, one which put us in a good position to invest in the technology we have been coveting for some time.

Our excitement lasted mere weeks before COVID-19 emerged. As is typical for late February, few Journeys had been completed, but we also began to see the rest of the year's Journeys cancelling. We were confronted with the possibility of a year, very possibly two, without the vital Journey fees which finance our operations.

The FFI Board, our indefatigable CEO Jeremi, and the loyal staff members at FFI, worked quickly to examine the best course of action. We were determined to do whatever we could to guarantee that throughout the crisis, Friendship Force would keep running and keep our mission alive. It was a very difficult time. The challenge for the Board was the prospect of maintaining a viable organisation for up to two years, without physical Journeys and without the vital cash flow required to sustain it.

When Jeremi proposed the seemingly audacious plan to raise operating funds via an appeal to the membership, it seemed impossible, but the Board stood with Jeremi in facing this challenge.

However, by now you are all aware that through the incredible generosity of our members around the world, we raised almost \$500,000 USD. More than that, this money

was given with open hearts and encouraging words of support. I can't tell you how many wonderfully inspiring messages I have received from members everywhere, emphasizing the absolute necessity for Friendship Force in the world and in our lives.

Reaching this point has necessitated an enormous amount of work. Each board member has been called on to attend many extra meetings, some of them at quite extraordinary times of the day or night. I must take a moment, too, to assure you of the dedication of our wonderful CEO who has given, unstintingly, of his time, his energy and his imagination throughout the entire year. He is simply unique.

You, our members, are our greatest resource. We thank you for your support during this inconceivable period of adversity and we trust that you will stay the course, as we work toward returning to what we do so very well – making friends in all corners of the world.

The thoughts of the board members are well and truly with you. We wish you the opportunity to spend time with your loved ones and to look forward to new possibilities in 2021.


